I can't install Aptana the way it describes in the book. What should I do?

Although we recommended Aptana Studio 3 as the text editor to use when our book was published, it's no longer supported and has become difficult to install. So now, we recommend that you use Brackets as your text editor instead. Brackets, which was developed by Adobe, is free, easy to use, has some excellent features, and runs on Windows, Mac, and Linux systems.
